

CYBER HIGH SCHOOL **CYBER PROGRAM**



The Cyber High School Program provides a unique opportunity for students from underrepresented communities to learn valuable skills in cyber-security. They receive free training over 8 - 10 weeks, which includes instructor-led lessons and onsite work experience with cybersecurity professionals. This program is offered during the summer months to provide kids time off school without interfering with academics or other commitments they may have outside of their education.



The curriculum includes computer programming & coding 101; comptia security+ certification preparation coursework; digital forensics investigation training with the latest forensic tools and techniques from leading vendors in the industry such as guidance software's encase enterprise, access data's forensic toolkit (FTK), and cellebrite mobile analyzer; ethical hacking & penetration testing training using the latest tools and techniques from leading vendors in the industry such as rapid 7 metasploit pro edition software, backtrack 5 R3 linux operating system, kaspersky lab anti -malware and vulnerability scanner, and mcafee web gateway appliances.

In addition to the training and certification courses, there is also coursework that teaches students about cyber-defense and cybersecurity policy.

OUR GOAL

Cyber-attacks are becoming more and more common, but there isn't enough qualified talent to fight them off. Diversity Cyber Council is working hard for disadvantaged groups to improve career opportunities in the cybersecurity field.
